1. SELECTION OF PARTICIPANTS

The following rules apply for the selection of participants:

Staff applying to the Erasmus+ KA107 mobility programme should satisfy the following conditions:

- 1.1. being a full-time academic staff at University of Sarajevo, Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Department of Computer Science and Informatics
- 1.2. should have at least one full semester of teaching experience at University of Sarajevo, Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Department of Computer Science and Informatics if applying to the Mobility for Teaching Programme.

Staff applying for mobility (for teaching and for training) will receive an Erasmus grant for 7 days (5 days at Bursa Technical + 2 days for travel).

The Erasmus grants for staff are: 140 Euros per day + 275 Euros for travel expenses = 1.255 Euros

The payment of the grants will be done in Bursa Technical University during the mobility week.
